The above mentioned cards permits the user to benefit from national dealers in the following sectors, while traveling in Italy, purchases on-line, restaurants, cultural and free time indicated in the "guide services" that will be consigned to you with the card.

The IT-CARD

- Can be released to Italian citizens who are registered and are residing in the district of this Consulate office.
- Requests can be made in person or via mail with a letter containing your name, address, telephone number and e-mail address, if available.
- You may personally consign this request or by mail with a self addressed and stamped envelope.




