#### A Message from the Club President



By the time you will have received this newsletter we will have held our **Appreciation Dinner** for all the Club volunteers on October 1st and our fall dance, which **Mary Wierzba** and her daughter, **Janice Labadie**, are chairing on October 4th.

At our September Spaghetti Dinner we served 777 dinners.

That leaves just one last Spaghetti Dinner on October 15th. We continue to have a sufficient number of volunteers to serve the large crowds each month.

At our September meeting we elected the Nominations and Election Committee, which consists of **Shirley Cavataio**, **Nancy DiPasquale**, **Nancy Marcantonio**, **Pina Milewski and Grace Randazzo**. At the October meeting, this committee will be accepting nominations for the 2009-2010 officers of the Club. We will hold elections in November. Make sure you attend this meeting and participate in the nominations process.

Mary Cottone contacted DTE and an Energy Audit was performed in June. Our building committee (Jim Bedemian, Tony Lumia Mary Cottone and myself) have had two meetings to discuss energy saving initiatives. The first step is the replacement of 147 incandescent flood bulbs and 140 fluorescent bulbs with new energy saving bulbs. We expect this to significantly reduce our monthly lighting bills. Next, we will be installing motion sensors in the bathrooms, furnace room, liquor room and Jeanne's storage room and repairing the insulation at exterior doors. Other energy saving improvements are being planned.

The **Members' Christmas Party** is scheduled for Saturday December 20th. There will be a New Years Dance.

#### **Nominations**

In accordance with Article VII - COMMITTEES, Section 4-NOMINATION AND ELECTION COMMITTEE, the nomination of officers is to be held at the October 22, 2006 General Membership meeting. The Nomination Committee persons are:

Grace Randazzo, (Chairperson) Shirley Cavataio Nancy DiPasquale Nancy Marcantonio Pina Milewski

Anyone who wishes to run for Club Office must be present and verbally accept. If the nominee is not present, his/her written permission must be presented to the Nomination and Election Committee prior to the acceptance of nomination.

Article II - DUES AND ASSESSMENTS, Section 1-A states: "New members shall not be eligible to run for office, or vote in the election of officers, until his/her application has been accepted by the general membership at or before the June general assembly meeting."

Officers to be elected are: President, Vice-President, Recording Secretary, Financial Corresponding Secretary, Treasurer, Assistant Treasurer, Inside Guard, Outside Guard, Guide, and four (4) Trustees.

An amendment to Article 8, Section 4, of the By-Laws was voted on and passed at the general membership meeting of June 27, 1993.

"Any member in good standing wishing to obtain an absentee ballot, may do so by applying to the D.I.A.C. c/o the Nomination and Election Committee, within 30 days in advance of the election. Thus enabling members, who cannot come in person, an opportunity to cast their vote by obtaining an absentee ballot. The absentee ballot will be mailed to the voter, within 20 days, prior to the election. The absentee ballot must be in the hands of the Committee on election day, for the ballot to be counted."

My blood pressure pills make me dizzy," another went on.


"I guess that's the price we pay for getting old," winced an old man as he shook his head.
