The Club By-Laws states the following:

ARTICLE IV - OFFICER STATUS

Any member in good standing shall be eligible for office in the Club. Being deemed an honor, the position of any officer shall be non-salaried. New officers are elected at the November election membership meeting and their term of office shall start on January 1st. The Executive Committee, including only the President, Vice President, Recording Secretary, Treasurer, Assistant Treasurer, and Financial Corresponding Secretary, shall not be of the immediate family (husband, wife, children, brother and sisters).

A Club Officer shall not serve concurrently as a Board member of the DIA Hall.

The term for Officer is 2 years. The four (4) Trustees position has a term of 4 years.

The nominations of club officers for 2011-2012 will include: President, Vice President, Secretary, Financial Corresponding Secretary, Treasurer, Assistant Treasurer, Inside Guard, Outside Guard, Guide and 4 Trustees.
