The 120-gallon hot water holding tank in the kitchen area was replaced in early March. The existing tank (installed in 1998) showed many signs of aging. The Club Board approved funding for the replacement tank in late

February. Piping material changes were made to minimize contaminant. The pasta events will greatly appreciate the new hot water supply. The kitchen hot water system is heated by a natural gas fired boiler and the water is stored in a holding tank for use in the kitchen and the restroom facilities.

# A Story of a Carob Tree (A famous Talmudic story)




A young boy was walking on a road and saw a man of many years planting a carob tree.


