Pasta Event - Oct. 16, 2013




The September pasta event was smaller and unusual with only 419 meals served (between dining and carry-outs). There was a less turnout

Medicare Pays for Flu Shots



As you plan your schedule this fall, should getting a flu shot be a part of it?

Influenza or "flu" is a respiratory disease caused by a virus. It is spread through droplets of moisture released into the air when an infected person talks, sneezes or

coughs.

Flu symptoms include fever, chills, headaches, exhaustion, loss of appetite, a dry cough and aches and pains.

The flu can be dangerous, especially for the elderly, because it can lead to complications such as pneumonia or bronchitis.

According to the Centers for Disease Control, the flu claims an estimated 10,000-40,000 lives each year. The majority of these deaths are among people over 65 – almost all of whom have not been immunized.

Who's at Risk?

You are at high risk for catching the flu if you:

- Are over the age of 50.
- Have a long-term illness, such as lung, heart or kidney disease and diabetes.
- Are taking certain medication.
- Are a health care worker

Flu season will be well under way by November. Since it takes at least 30 days to develop immunity, October is the best time to get a flu shot.

Medicare covers payment for annual flu vaccinations.
